

Kelley, Cotrona, Ihrig, and Reidy lead the Waves in Vermont

The Lake Champlain Waves competed at St. Michaels College in Colchester Vermont on January 31, 2010. The Waves sent twenty two swimmers to compete in this event. Leading the Waves was Brooke Kelley, Sierra Cotrona, Preston Ihrig, and Hayden Reidy.

Brooke Kelley competed in five events in the girl's 10 & under division. She picked up two first place, one second place and two fourth place ribbons. Kelley placed first in the 100-yard Breaststroke (Breast) with a personal best time of 1.30.57 and in the 100-yard Butterfly (Fly) in 1.31.91. She was second in the 50-yard Breast with a personal best time of 41.13. Kelley also placed fourth in the 50-yard Freestyle (Free) in 33.79 and fourth in the 100-yard Free in 1.13.83.

Sierra Cotrona, swimming in the girl's Open division, finished first in the 400-yard Individual Medley (IM) with a time of 5.11.87. That was the first time she has ever competed in that event. Cotrona finished third in the 200-yard Free with a time of 2.11.88. She also placed seventh in the 200-yard Breast in 2.48.12, eighth in the 100-yard Breast in 1.18.02, and tenth in the 200-yard IM in 2.31.63.

Preston Ihrig competed in three events in the boy's 8 & under division. All of his times were personal bests. Ihrig placed second in the 25-yard Backstroke (Back) in 22.72, third in the 25-yard Fly in 29.35, and fourth in the 25-yard Free in 20.62. His time in the 25-yard Fly was 5.72 seconds faster than his previous best.

Haden Reidy swam in four events in the boy's 11-12 year old division. He finished third in the 50-yard Breast with a personal best time of 42.13. Reidy placed sixth in the in 100-yard IM with a personal best time of 1.27.86 and sixth in the 100-yard Free in 1.17.33. He also placed tenth in the 50-yard Free in 34.62. Reidy's time in the 100-yard IM was 2.57 seconds faster than his previous best.

Brittany Friedrich took a fourth place finish in the 200-yard Breast with a personal best time of 2.44.39. She placed fifth in the 100-yard Breast in 1.16.48, and sixth in the 400-yard IM in 5.25.55. Friedrich also competed in the 200-yard IM in 2.34.84 in a personal best time of 2.34.84, and in the 50-yard Free in 28.99. She competed in the girl's Open division.

Zackary Raymond swam in the boy's 10 & under division. He placed fourth in the 50-yard Back in 44.74, fifth in the 100-yard Free in 2.26.53, eighth in the 100-yard IM in 1.41.23, and ninth in the 50-yard Free in 38.15. While all of Raymond's times were personal bests, his effort in the 100-yard IM was 7.67 seconds faster than his previous best.

Molly Wilkins, competing in the girl's Open division, took fourth place in the 200-yard Free with a time of 2.14.18. She finished seventh in the 500-yard Free in 6.02.10, eleventh in the 50-yard Free in 28.76, and twelfth in the 100-yard Back in 1.10.88. Wilkins' time of 2.35.19 in the 200-yard IM was 7.85 seconds faster than her previous best.

Stella Boolukos-Brinker finished fourth in the 50-yard Back with a personal best time of 36.22. Swimming in the girl's 11-12 year old division, she took tenth place in the 100-yard Free in 1.15.07, and eleventh in the 200-yard Back in 2.55.33. Boolukos-Brinker also recorded personal bests in the 100-yard Back in 1.21.84, and in the 200-yard IM in 3.11.76, which was 2.71 seconds faster than her previous best.

Taylor Hall competed in the girl's Open division, taking fifth place in the 400-yard IM in 5.29.87, and seventh in the 200-yard Back in 2.38.50. She also swam in the 100-yard Back in 1.12.29, the 50-yard Free in 29.82, and the 100-yard Free in 1.05.83.

Haani Qudsi, swimming in the boy's 12 & under division, placed sixth in the 50-yard Breast with a time of 44.84. He also took eighth place in the 50-yard Free in 34.16, eighth in the 100-yard Free in 1.19.54, and ninth in the 100-yard IM in 2.34.14.

Alexis Kelley took sixth place in the 200-yard Free in 2.14.54. She also placed ninth in the 100-yard Breast with a personal best time of 1.18.80. Kelley's time of 1.15.37 in the 100-yard Fly was 4.05 seconds faster than her previous best in that event. She also competed in the 100-yard Free in 1.02.87, and in the 50-yard Free in 29.67. Kelley swam in the girl's open division.

Kenneth Hausrath competed in the boy's Open division. He placed seventh in the 200-yard Breast with a personal best time of 3.10.51. Hausrath also competed in the 100-yard Breast in 1.29.48, the 100-yard Free in 1.09.70, and the 50-yard Free in 30.16.

Hamzah Qudsi placed ninth in the in the 200-yard IM in 2.34.14, and tenth in the in the 100-yard Fly in 1.11.14. Competing in the boy's Open division, he also swam in the 100-yard Free in 1.00.79, and in the 100-yard Back in 1.09.56.

Spencer Hall, who also competed in the boy's Open division, finished ninth in the 200-yard Free in 2.30.72. He also swam in the 200-yard IM in 2.54.78, the 100-yard Free in 1.08.47, and in the 50-yard Free in 31.85. Hall's time of 1.20.59 in the 100-yard Back was 1.82 seconds faster than his previous best time.

Mary Barkla swam in the girl's open division. She finished tenth in the 200-yard back with a time of 2.44.68. She also competed in the 200-yard Free in 2.37.12, the 100-yard Back in

1.14.51, the 50-yard Free in 31.63, and the 200-yard IM in 2.56.76. Barkla's times in the 100-yard Back and the 50-yard Free were personal bests.

Emily McCormick swimming in the girl's 10 & under division, swam personal bests in the 100-yard Free and the 50-yard Free. Her time of 1.29.01 was 2.29 seconds faster than her best time in that event, and her time of 39.20 in the 50-yard Free was 0.84 seconds faster than she's swum in that event.

Mikayla Fountain also swam in the girl's 10 & under division. She competed 100-yard Breast in 2.09.54, the 50-yard Breast in a personal best time of 57.76, the 50-yard Back in 56.53, the 100-yard IM in 2.06.13, and the 100-yard Free in 1.55.01.

This was Michaela Butler's first meet as a Wave. She competed in the 50-yard Fly in 44.92, the 100-yard Free in 1.34.71, the 200-yard Free in 3.06.14, and the 50-yard Free in 40.31. Butler swam in the girl's 11-12 year old division.

Rebecca Brown swam girl's Open division. She swam in the 100-yard Back 1.23.02, knocking 1.14 second off her previous best time. Brown also swam in the 100-yard Fly in 1.19.86, the 200-yard Free in 2.28.86, and the 50-yard Free in 32.67.

Amber Geddes also swam in the girl's Open division. Her time of 2.51.81 in the 200-yard IM was 2.00 seconds faster than her previous best. Geddes also competed in the 50-yard Free in 30.26, the 100-yard Breast in 1.27.70, the 100-yard Free in 1.05.52, and the 100-yard Back in 1.23.44.

Megan Zmijewski improved her time in the 100-yard Free by a whopping 7.61 seconds with a time of 1.29.20. She also improved her times in the 50-yard Breast in 51.51 and the 100-yard IM in 1.42.07. Swimming in the girl's 11-12 year old division, Zmijewski also competed in the 50-yard Back in 49.20 and the 50-yard Free in 38.51.

Alison Golden swam in the girl's 10 & under division. She took 1.49 seconds off her best time in the 50-yard Free with a time of 44.90. She also competed in the 50-yard Back with a time of 1.00.48.
